We award the better performers in academic and other activities at this occasion.

Health & Hygiene

Conveyance

The school provides bus service to students on request subject to the availability of accommodation at certain fee which is revisable time to time.

Free- Studentship

Free - studentship is provided to 25% students preferably to poor, orphan, needy and meritorious students in every academic session.

Awards/Prizes

To boost the morale, to give encouragement and to nourish their talent different awards and prizes are given to students both for curricular and extra curricular achievements annually.

Functions.

The School organises various functions to celebrate different occasions of national and Milli importance. It also organises annual function every year in which large number of students are encouraged to participate to demonstrate their scholastic and cognitive ability and talents on the stage.

A small donation is taken from each student for such events .



Teachers' Training Camp

This is a unique phenomenon of our school. We arrange academic training programme for our teachers periodically to develop their academic capabilities and teaching skills as well as to akin them with the basic principles of this school. The management tries to forge a cordial and healthy relation with teachers .

Discipline

Discipline is the core of our teaching. punctuality, regularity, probity, truthfulness and cleanliness are the basic tenets of this school.

The school has its dress code. 75% attendance is mandatory. In case of leave and absence prior information and permission is essential.



DISMISSAL/WITHDRAWAL

The school reserves the right to remove any student on account of misconduct, violation of school's norms and indisciplinary activities.

One month prior notice will be required for the withdrawal of a child from the school. If a student remains absent from school for a month consecutively without informing or taking permission, his/her name will be struck down from the class role.



REGISTRATION & ADMISSION

Registration for admission starts two months before the beginning of the academic year. Registration does not ensure admission. Admission will be made strictly on the basis of admission test and personal interview with the student and guardian. The school reserves the right to decide in which standard the student is eligible for admission. The decision of the school authority is final.

Age eligibility of admission in different standards:

Session	-	April to March



EXAMINATION & TEST

Four examinations are conducted in an academic session i.e. Two Formative Assessments (F.A-I & II) and two summative Assessments (S.A-I & II). Result is prepared on the basis of all the four exams conducted during one session.

In F.A-I & II, 50% questions are of objective type & short type while 50% are subjective type in S.A-I & II. All questions are as per pattern of CBSE curriculum.

Parents Meet

It is prerogative on the part of parents and guardians to attend such meetings that are organised periodically to apprise them with the development and other issues related to their ward(s) and the school. The school tries to forge a cordial and close relationship with guardians and teachers for the timely redressal of issues and better upbringing of children.

If guardian fails to attend two meetings in a row without information, the name of his/her ward (s) may be struck off from the school.
